New Gift Card Program

A new gift card program will launch soon, replacing the old Occoquan Business Partners paper gift cards. In the new program, customers will purchase a card (physical or digital) that can be run as a credit card. A few quick highlights of the program include:

- Open to ALL Occoquan businesses in good standing
- Can only be used with Occoquan businesses in the 22125 boundaries
- Can be used in store and online
- Anyone who accepts Mastercard will be able to participate
- Payment is automatic through your regular credit card processing. No more spending time turning in gift cards, then waiting for a check to arrive.
- Customers can purchase gift cards easily online, with instant access to a digital version (print at home or to use online) or receive a physical card, sent directly by our gift card partner.
- The new program will rely less on Visit Occoquan volunteers and be more accessible and easier to use for both customers and Occoquan businesses participating.
